

## *Direct actions for students with 66% or more disability*

### **Housing service**

- Advantages are provided according to merit, economical conditions (by providing the ISEE declaration) and the duration of the degree:
  - Bachelor (3 years) for 5 years
  - Master Course for 4 years
  - Master Course at C.U. for the legal duration of the degree + 2 years
- Students with physical and visual disabilities are granted access regardless of the distance of their residence to the university
- Students with physical disabilities **are entitled to two carers**
- For those students **eligible** to enter the competition or **ineligible due to merit, with ISEE declaration within the specified limits**, there is no fee adjustment for the hospitality of the carer.
- The students, **not eligible due to ISEE declaration too high**, must pay a fee for the carer as follows:
  - 50% with ISEE declaration up to Euro 55,000.00
  - 100% with ISEE declaration higher than Euro 55,000.00

## Regional Scholarship

- Advantages are provided according to merit, economical conditions (by providing the ISEE declaration) and the duration of the degree:
  - Bachelor for 9 semesters
  - Master Course for 7 semesters
  - Master Course at C.U. for the legal duration of the degree + 3 semesters
- No provisions are applied to those enrolled in the first year, provided that:
  - The second instalment is subordinated to the reaching of 20 credits by 10<sup>th</sup> August;
  - The benefit is cancelled if the student does not obtain 20 credits by 30<sup>th</sup> November.
- Waiver of tuition fees **regardless of the percentage of disability**

## Accompanying activities

- The student interested in carer activities can inform:
- → the ESU by filling in the Form for the request of University accommodation
- → By email to [dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it](mailto:dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it) to indicate his/her availability
- The carer receives **free** accommodation and catering services
- The accompanying experience has to be a synergy between the needs of the student and the 'availability' of the carer. *Example: a "written agreement" between the interested parties could be useful.*
